Dear Beloved Parishioners

Some call it Sunday School, others Religious Formation, still others Maronite Catholic Formation. We give several names to describe one reality that is "an hour" of catechesis on Sundays. The various descriptions given to one entity could mean that it is so rich in its significances that one interpretation cannot encompass it all. It could also mean that we are so confused about the objectives and roles of that entity that each one of us explains it as he or she sees it. In fact, there are three main purposes that the Maronite Catholic Formation tries to convey.

First, the Maronite Catholic Formation strives to emphasize the spiritual side of its program. It is not only about information, but primarily about cultivating and forming in our students a spiritual attitude. Our society forces us to be secularized and pushes us to forget about spirituality and religious matters. Lately, there is a tendency to classify spiritual people as weak in their personality and hiding from the world behind their beliefs to avoid facing their problems. This is a challenge to all of us - students, teachers, parents, and priests - to show that through spirituality we can attain our full humanity. Conflicts, problems, and struggles are seen differently when we look at them through spiritual lenses.

The second purpose is academic or informational. As an Eastern Catholic Church, tradition is our source of understanding and reasoning. We have over 2000 years of tradition that we cannot ignore or change simply because it is not modern. In fact, the word 'tradition' comes from the Latin verb *traditio* which means to trade, exchange, or to hand down. Thus, tradition is what was handed down to us from our ancestors and it is our responsibility to hand it down faithfully to the next generation. The wisdom of our forefathers enshrined in their teaching is what makes our tradition academically rich. The respect and reverence that we express to our forefathers become a way of formation. Thus, our tradition is what forms our students and makes them knowledgeable about their faith.

The third purpose is social in nature. A friendship emerges between the students, parents, and teachers of the same religious education program. For instance, if we take the First Communion Class, the students of that class will remember forever that they made their First Communion with this or that person. Discussing the never-ending details of the First Communion Ceremony - the decoration, the photographer or what is the appropriate dress - is an opportunity for parents to get to know each other better.

These three purposes reflect in a very meaningful way the proclamation of the Word of God. The proclamation of the Good News is spiritual because it talks about God's plan of salvation and has to be interpreted based on the deposit of faith. Finally, for a real effect, the Word of God is proclaimed in its social context. Allow me on this Sunday of the Maronite Catholic Formation Open House to encourage all of you, students and teachers, to take more time to pray, read and be taught by the living Word of God, so all of us can proclaim it to its full measure.

The MYO of the Cathedral's Lock-in will be postponed. Instead, there will be a meeting on Sunday October 21 after the 11:30 Divine Liturgy.



The Sixth Sunday after The Cross The Letter to the Galatians 6:1-10

My friends, if anyone is detected in a transgression, you who have received the Spirit should restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness. Take care that you yourselves are not tempted. Bear one another's burdens, and in this way you will fulfil the law of Christ. For if those who are nothing think they are something, they deceive themselves.

All must test their own work; then that work, rather than their neighbor's work, will become a cause for pride. For all must carry their own loads. Those who are taught the word must share in all good things with their teacher. Do not be deceived; God is not mocked, for you reap whatever you sow. If you sow to your own flesh, you will reap corruption from the flesh; but if you sow to the Spirit, you will reap eternal life from the Spirit. So let us not grow weary in doing what is right, for we will reap at harvest time, if we do not give up. So then, whenever we have an opportunity, let us work for the good of all, and especially for those of the family of faith.

'For it is as if a man, going on a journey, summoned his slaves and entrusted his property to them;

to one he gave five talents, to another two, to another one, to each according to his ability. Then he went away.
