Dear Beloved Parishioners:

Last week's Gospel taken from Luke continues the story that was proclaimed four weeks ago in the Divine Liturgy when Jesus appeared to two of his disciples going to Emmaus. After they recognized him at the breaking of the bread, the two disciples came back to Jerusalem and were telling the others what happened to them and how Jesus was made known to them. while they were talking about this, Jesus himself stood among them and said, "Peace be with vou."

The language of peace and the expression of "Peace be with you" is characteristic of the resurrection. Before his resurrection, Christ only spoke about peace in general. For instance, one of the Beatitudes in Matthew 5 reads, "Blessed are the peacemakers for they will be called the children of God." In his last discourse in John's Gospel, he also talked about peace: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid."

After his resurrection, Jesus would enter through closed doors, stand in the midst of his disciples and greet them saying, "Peace to you." For many of us, this is a simple greeting we hear all the time and in our modern world everyone says, "Peace." But said by the risen Lord, it acquires new significance because it brings about an inner change; it is the Easter greeting that enables the disciples to overcome all fear. The peace that Jesus brings is the gift of salvation and not a mere salutation. The resurrected Lord wanted to offer his friends his salvation, but at the same time he gave them the task to spread the same peace.

Against that peace, serenity and tranquility of the Lord, society is pushing us to be like the lion and the gazelle in the following story. Every morning in Africa, a gazelle wakes up. It knows it must run faster than the fastest lion or it will be killed. Every morning a lion wakes up. It knows it must outrun the slowest gazelle or it will starve to death. It doesn't matter whether you're a lion or a gazelle; when the sun comes up, you'd better be running.

The word peace is very prominent in the Divine Liturgy to remind us of the gift of peace and the task to spread it. At the beginning the priest says, "Peace be with the Church and her children." Then throughout the celebration, "Peace be with you. And with your spirit" is exchanged between the priest and the congregation at least three times. Every Anaphora starts with the sign of peace emanating from the Altar to the priest and then the congregation. At the very end of the celebration, the priest prays silently, "I leave you in peace O holy

Altar of God and I hope to return to you in peace..."



Letter to the Ephesians 1: 15-23

I have heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love towards all the saints, and for this reason I do not cease to give thanks for you as I remember you in my prayers.
