

Dear Parishioners and Friends:

To understand last Sunday's Gospel from Luke 10: 21-24, it is necessary to read the passage in its immediate context. The beginning of Luke 10 narrates how Jesus appointed seventy others and sent them on ahead of him in pairs to every town and place where he himself intended to go. "Carry no purse, no bag, no sandals," he told them, "and whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this house!' Cure the sick who are there, and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.' " In addition to the twelve apostles that Jesus called in Luke 6, the seventy disciples were given the task to extend Jesus' mission. Two by two, they went ahead of Jesus to announce the kingdom of God which brings peace and healing to those who are ill. Jesus also encouraged them saying, "Whoever listens to you listens to me, and whoever rejects you rejects me."

After their mission ministering to the people, the seventy returned with joy because they experienced God's power working through them. Jesus had given them authority to tread on snakes and scorpions, and to cast out demons and all the powers of the Enemy. As they did all that, nothing hurt them. Whatever Jesus was planning on doing in the towns and villages, the seventy as his delegates were able to do since his power was transmitted to them.

Last week's Gospel began with Jesus rejoicing in the Spirit when he received reports from the seventy disciples as they came back from their mission. So he exclaimed, "I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and the intelligent and have revealed them to infants; yes, Father, for such was your gracious will." The immense power that Jesus had given the seventy disciples was used to help others and not to exercise dominion. His understanding of power is to serve. In Mark 10: 43-44, Jesus was clear when he said, "Whoever wishes to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wishes to be first among you must be slave of all."

Nowadays, most people who exercise power do it differently. Lord Acton, a famous English Catholic historian, politician, and writer, once said, "Power tends to corrupt, and absolute power corrupts absolutely." It is amazing how the application of power changes as people get older. Usually, when children are given a responsibility to do something, they apply their power to do the task at hand perfectly. Their entire focus is to fulfill their assignment and do a good job to serve others. However, when adults are given power, in most cases, the first thing they ask is, "What's in it for me?" This is when power can turn into abuse and exploitation.

God has revealed to the childlike the proper application of power. May the Holy Spirit help us discover the child within us especially when it comes

to the exercise of power.

#### Letter of Paul to the Philippians 3: 7-14

Yet whatever gains I had, these I have come to regard as loss because of Christ.

More than that, I regard everything as loss because of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things, and I regard them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but one that comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God based on faith.

I want to know Christ and the power of his resurrection and the sharing of his sufferings by becoming like him in his death, if somehow I may attain the resurrection from the dead.

Not that I have already obtained this or have already reached the goal; but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own.

Beloved, I do not consider that I have made it my own; but this one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on towards the goal for the prize of the heavenly call of God in Christ Jesus.

#### The Gospel of Saint Matthew 10: 1-7

Then Jesus summoned his twelve disciples and gave them authority over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to cure every disease and every sickness.

These are the names of the twelve apostles:

first, Simon, also known as Peter, and his brother Andrew; James son of Zebedee, and his brother John; Philip and Bartholomew; Thomas and Matthew the tax-collector; James son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus; Simon the Cananaean, and Judas Iscariot, the one who betrayed him. These twelve Jesus sent out with the following instructions: 'Go nowhere among the Gentiles, and enter no town of the Samaritans, but go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

As you go, proclaim the good news, "The kingdom of heaven has come near."
