9GENERAL CONDITIONS

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Transportation is in economy class on regular scheduled IATA Airline. Fare is based on GROUP/APEX as applicable for groups flying together for entire itinerary.

LAND TRANSPORTATION: As specified in each itinerary is by modern air-conditioned buses designed especially for sightseeing. The cost of the land arrangements, as outline in this itinerary, is based on a busload ranging from **21-39** passengers.

HOTELS First Class Hotels, twin bedded rooms with private facilities. Cruise is based on **two lower beds outside cabins (XA).** Limited single rooms are available at an extra charge **(\$1298)**. They have to be requested and confirmed prior to departure.

MEALS AND SIGHTSEEING: Meals consisting of breakfast and dinner daily on land and all meals while on board are included. Shore excursions to Ephesus, House of the Virgin Mary, Patmos and Knossos are included in the tour price. Local transportation by bus or local conveyance as indicated, the service of an English-speaking tour escort and local guides, and the entrance fees to places visited on sightseeing tours as indicated in the itinerary.

SUMMARY OF OUR DAILY ACTIVITIES

DAY 01 (SUN) NEW YORK/SALONICA

Depart late in the afternoon from JFK Int'l airport on our flight to Salonica via Istanbul. Full service on board.

DAY 02 (MON) SALONICA

Upon arrival we'll be met by our local representative and our guide and transfer to our hotel. Afternoon at leisure. Dinner and overnight.

DAY 03 (TUE) **PHILIPPI**

Full day sightseeing. We drive east to Philippi. The New Testament records a visit to the city by the apostle Paul during his second missionary journey. Accompanied by Silas, by Timothy and possibly Luke. Paul is believed to have preached for the first time on European soil in Philippi. We will visit the magnificent Acropolis, the Market Place, the Theater and the two early Christian Churches. On the way back will stop at the town of Kavala (Neapolis) where St. Paul first landed in Europe. Return to **Salonica** for dinner and overnight.

DAY 04 (WED) SALONICA/VERIA VERGINA/KALAMBAKA

Morning sightseeing of Salonica (Thessaloniki). It is the second-largest city in Greece with over 1 million inhabitants and the capital of Greek Macedonia. Our sightseeing this morning will include the Arch of Galerius, St. Demetrius, St. Sophia, the White

and see St. Paul's Bema. Apostle Paul famously breached in the city and its inhabitants were among the first Christians in the Empire. From here we continue to Vergina and visit the breathtaking Tombs of Macedonian Kings. Continue to Kalambaka for dinner and overnight.

DAY 05 (THU) METEORA/ATHENS

Morning visit **Meteora.** It is a rock formation in central

Greece hosting one of the largest and most precipitously built complexes of Eastern Orthodox Monasteries, second in importance to Mount Athos. The ageless Byzantine Monasteries that stands suspended between earth and the sky, containing priceless and religious treasures. Visit two monasteries. Depart for Athens with a short stop at Kammena Vourla to visit Leonida's Monument. Dinner and overnight in Athens.

DAY 06 (FRI) ATHENS/PIRAEUS/MYKONOS

Morning transfer to Piraeus to board the ship for a 3day Cruise to the Greek Isles and Turkey. Afternoon call at Mykonos, known as "The Island of the Winds". Tourism is a major industry and is known for its nightlife. Evening sail for Kusadasi (Turkey).

DAY 07 (SAT) EPHESUS/PATMOS

This morning we arrive at the Turkish port of Kusadasi where we visit Ephesus and the House of Virgin Mary. Ephesus was famed for the nearby **Ancient World**. Among many other monuments are

DAY07 (SAT) **CONTINUED** the Library of Celsus and the theatre, capable of

holding 25,000 spectators. Ephesus was one of the Seven Churches of Asia that are sited in the Book of Revelation. Visit the House of the Virgin Mary before we return to the ship and sail for Patmos. It is a small Greek Island, most famous for being the location of the vision given to the disciple John in the Book of Revelation in the New Testament and where the book was written. Visit St. John's Monastery and Grotto. Evening sail for Heraklion, Crete.

DAY 08 (SUN) HERAKLION/SANTORINI

This morning we arrive at Greece's largest island, Crete. We visit Knossos, the largest Bronze Age Archaeological site on Crete, and has been called

DAY 08 (SUN) CONTINUED Europe's oldest city. We visit the Palace of King Minos. Afternoon sail for the volcano island of Santorini. The island was the site of the largest

volcanic eruptions in recorded history, the Minoan eruption called the Thera which occurred about 3,000 years ago at the height of the Minoan civilization. Another popular theory holds that the Thera eruption is the source of the legend of Atlantis. Evening sail for Piraeus.

DAY 09 (MON) ATHENS/CORINTH

Arrive in Piraeus, meet with our guide and drive to Corinth. Visit the Archaeological Museum, Bema, the Market Place and the Temples. After a short stop at the Corinth Canal, return to Athens. In the afternoon, visit the Aeropagus (Mars Hill) and the Acropolis with its magnificent ruins of the Golden Age of Athens, the Propylaea, the Temple of Athena Nike and the famous Parthenon. View the Agora and the Ancient Hill of Pnyka. After a short orientation tour of Athens, return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

After breakfast transfer to Athens airport for the return flight to JFK Int'l Airport, via Istanbul. Arrive home in the evening of the same day.
