Analyze the importance of the story of the Good Samaritan. (not to exceed 500 words)

What does the story of Jesus and the disciples walk to Emmaus mean to you? (not to exceed 1000 words)



## **CONTEST GUIDELINES**

- 1) All entries must be the original work of the entrant. Any entries that are noticeably not the work of the individual student will be disqualified.
- 2) Each student may enter only **ONE** category.
- 3) **NO GROUP** entries. This is an individual student competition.
- 4) Each parish may submit up to three (3) entries per category/grade level.
- 5) POSTERS MUST BE on 14 x 22 Poster Board Paper. Any other paper format will be disqualified.
- 6) Entries must be clearly marked, on the back, and grouped by age group with a paper clip or divider.
- 7) Individual participants can mail in their own entries but must indicate parish affiliation and city and state.
- 8) All entries must have the student's name, address, parish name, grade level and age (CLEARLY WRITTEN OR TYPED.)
- 9) All entries must be post marked by May 15, 2023, and mailed to:
